



What do Speech Pathologists do?

Peach Speech Pathology offers assessment and therapy for children and adults in the following areas:

Speech Sounds - production of clear sounds in speech.

Oral Language - difficulties with forming and understanding sentences, understanding words and word relationships, following instructions, expressing ideas and grammar.

Literacy Difficulties - including difficulties with reading, writing and spelling.

Social Skills - including difficulties with conversation, emotions and social interactions.


Stuttering - individuals having difficulty with fluency of speech.

Voice - individuals who have a poor voice quality and/or pain around the voice box.

Dysphagia/swallowing - individuals who have difficulty during meal times and drinking.

Referrals - to other services or professionals, such as language development schools.
